### 2025 Goal Areas - #2 Develop Leadership

Looking to the future, we need to develop more leaders. We have agreed to work with a pilot program called, HOPE Network Ministries Congregational Leadership Initiative (CLI). The following is an explanation of the program by HOPE Network:

As HOPE Network Ministries has worked with churches across North America we've heard a common concern, "We need to raise up next generation shepherds and leaders." In response, we've created a program to intentionally prepare a new generation of congregational leaders. We will work with a small group of your hand selected members and spouses to:

- Deepen discipleship and spiritual foundations
- Establish congregational leadership commitments within their work-life balance
- Strengthen emotional intelligence
- Introduce healthy leadership skills discernment, church leadership models, systems
- Understanding
- Expand theological foundations
- Explore critical cultural topics unique to your congregational setting

#### Overview

The CLI program consists of weekly, one-hour online sessions, led by experienced leaders from HOPE Network Ministries. Over the course of 12 months, participants will engage in a series of carefully curated topical units, designed to build key leadership skills. Throughout the program you will have one primary HOPE Network contact who will oversee the training. Each core unit will be facilitated by a subject-matter expert, ensuring that you receive top-tier instruction from the best in the field. The core units can be augmented with special interest units designed to explore important topics within your congregational setting.

Our Elders and I will go through the training along some next generation leaders and staff with the purpose of developing the Graham Street Church leadership, and to help HOPE Network fine tune the program. As the training continues we will enlarge the circle of leaders to be trained in various levels of ministry. Please be in prayer and willing to participate as we train and develop current and future leaders.




