#6 Missions

Missions is a broad category referring to our outreach beyond ourselves with the good news of God's saving grace – the Gospel. This includes Foreign and Domestic, ranging from our mission efforts in Zimbabwe to Campus Ministry and local Bible Studies with Basic Needs clients. The Prison Ministry with New Life Behaviors Bible Studies is a major part of our missions outreach. NLB is used by Stanley Shereni in Zimbabwe and in 231 prisons in 10 states including 212 in Texas, with an average of 70 studies being sent out on any given week. There are currently 23 volunteers that help with the Prison Ministry. We recommit ourselves to outreach, not just the big ministries, but the daily making of disciples by sharing our faith and the children's offering for Bibles.

#7 Celebrate Recovery and other needed Support Groups

There is a great need for Support Groups for our church family and the community. We cannot begin to measure the good that has been done by the support of our Celebrate Recovery ministry. But we need so many more! We want to continue to grow our SFG (Spiritual Formation Groups), Soup Kitchen, Grief Support, Bigger C Encouragers, etc. We need more support groups as part of the T4C Campus Ministry. We need to develop more support groups for discipleship and leadership development, and men's and women's support groups.

#8 GPS (Godly Parenting Skills) and Building Stronger Families

GPS connects to the Support Groups in #7 and as one of our Sunday morning Bible classes. We also have two small groups for our young families. We need to continue to provide support, encouragement, and teaching to build stronger marriages and families. And not just for our members, but also for the families of our community.


