

Fear Is A Reaction

Courage is a Decision

I have heard it many times in different forms: "Our elders were leading with faith and courage, and now we are in a season of fear." It just takes

one person in the name of shepherding to sow seeds of concern, question past decisions, or share a member's frustration. To be human is to feel anxiety. Chronic anxiety, however, is unhealthy and debilitating in every way: mind, body, soul, and Spirit. Without a mutual understanding of responding rather than reacting, anxiety escalates to unhealthy proportions. Anxiety is human. So make no mistake: If the leaders are anxious, the church will be too!

Attention to how the leadership group functions will pay big dividends in a church. As the leaders go, so goes the church.

Practically Speaking—A Few Essentials

• **Develop an Elder Covenant of Behavior**

How do WE model the life of Christ? (i.e., The Sermon on the Mount; The Fruit of the Spirit). How do we navigate disagreement and conflict? How do WE make decisions? What is our model?

Decide on Interaction Principles with the Church •

What are OUR priorities in shepherding? How do WE respond to a concern or complaint? How does Matthew 18.15f apply? What does a maturity in Christ conversation look like? What about emails and text messages?

• Determine the Habits for remaining focused on Mission

How do WE engage in spiritual formation? What ministry initiatives align with God's mission? How do WE partner an collaborate with the ministry staff for mission? What is our structure for empowering and equipping for mission?

Did you catch the emphasis on WE and US? Leadership is communal and it takes time and work. Anxiety-prone conversations must not dominate our time as leaders. Be strong and courageous. It's more than good advice; it's a way of being in Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit. Blessings, GDK




Compared to 2023, we saw 1,554 more individuals than we saw in 2024.

Young Adult Class


This Sunday, 03/23/2025, at 9:00 in Room 109, join Evan McLeroy as he leads the discussion on "Discipleship 101".
